A seminar on “**LEGAL RIGHTS FOR WOMEN**” was held in “**Bharathiyar Institute of Engineering for Women**”, Deviyakurichi by citizen consumer club on 02-11-2017. The chief guest was **Mr.S.SENTHIL KUMAR, B.A,B.L(M.L), CONSUMER ADVOCATE, ATTUR** has given an effective seminar on “**Legal Rights For Women**”.

In this Seminar, he highlighted the crimes against women occur every minute in india, womens are not safe, whether it is in their houses, public places (or) at work place. We live in a shady and mersed up world, where goddesses are maimed and harassed. The only way to keep an eye on such harrasic happenings is to make laws and rules skitter to keep a check on the crimes. Most people are unaware of their legal rights until they hire a legal firm for their problems. So, to help the women about their rights and to help them fight back by some of the act. “**Prohibition of child marriage**”. This act defines child marriage as a marriage where the groom or the bride are under age, that is, the bride is under 18 years of age or the boy is younger than 21 years. Parents trying to marry underage girls are subject to action under this law.



“**Dowry prohibition**”, According to this act, taking or giving of dowry at the time of the marriage to the bride or the bridegroom and their family is to be penalised. Dowry is often asked of the bride and her family by the groom and his family. The system has taken strong roots because women after marriage move in with their spouse and in-laws. It is one of the major challenges that our society is grappling with. A woman openly complaining about it has helped to spread the word and encourage other women to take a stand. “**Sexual harassment of women at workplace (prevention, prohibition)**”. To ensure women’s safety at workplace, this Act seeks to protect them from sexual harassment at their place of work. The government has threatened to take stern action against employers who fail to comply with this law.
